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Current Targets

Abridged **Manual ready** for Pilot Project Testing in 2014

- Credits must be useable in South Africa
- Weight of credits/scoring to be discussed
- GrSA project submission requirements must be feasible and beneficial

Robust Field Testing on Local Projects

- Diverse projects being sought (urban, rural, reseals, widenings, NMT upgrades, green fields, etc.)
- Early adoption of GrSA concepts
- Lessons learned:
 - Ease of Use of Each Credit (Cost vs. Benefit)
 - Project Owner attitudes throughout projects
 - Attainability of PRs and Credits
 - Levels of "Best-Practices"
