#### WHAT IS A MARK OF APPROVAL

#### Mark of Approval requirements include:

- Basic compliance with the Occupational, Health and Safety Act
- Proof of compliance with the Company's implemented Quality Management System
- Proof of compliance with the applicable product specification (SANS 1058 Concrete paving blocks) through records and testing of sampled products
- Ad hog sampling and testing of products from construction sites





#### WHAT IS A MARK OF APPROVAL

- The applicant will be assessed by a selected Systems/Technical Auditor, for compliance with the above requirements (E 16)
- With compliance the company will receive a certificate indicating compliance and approval for using the "CMA mark"
- This allows them to put the "mark" of approval on their product or paperwork as proof of compliance





#### CMA MARK

#### Why the CMA Mark?

- Construction industry and its financiers in South Africa are becoming increasingly aware of the value of using best quality products
- Products that have been specifically manufactured for construction projects under strictly controlled conditions





#### **CMA Mark versus SABS Mark**

- With SANAS accreditation it will mean that we operate from the same level of competence as any other international certification body
- The CMA Mark of approval will therefore be a valid and legitimate "Mark of Approval" for specified products, and will be the equivalent of the SABS Mark of approval
- The CMA Mark requirements will be strictly applied and only well trained and skilled auditors are utilised by CMA CS





#### **CMA Mark versus SABS Mark**

- According to current mark holders the current service provider has become insufficient and the validity of the current mark is seriously in doubt
- The decision was made to provide a thoroughly controlled and maintained alternative Mark of approval to the industry
