- 8<sup>th</sup> DUT Workshop and 12<sup>th</sup> ISCR were held in Prague, Czech Republic
- DUT Workshop held on 20 and 21 September 2014
- ISCR held from 23 to 26 September 2014

## 8<sup>th</sup> DUT Workshop

- "8<sup>th</sup> International DUT-Workshop on Research and Innovations for Design of Sustainable and Durable Concrete Pavements"
- Organised 4-yearly to coincide with ISCR
- 30 participants from 9 countries, 24 papers
- Keynote speech by Prof. A.A.A. Molenaar
- Organised around four themes:
  - I. Materials
  - II. Advanced analysis, design and evaluation of concrete pavements
  - III. Continuously reinforced concrete pavements
  - IV. Innovations
- More than 50% of time devoted to discussions





#### **Materials**

- 2 papers presented
- Main focus was on fatigue of concrete

#### Advanced analysis, design and evaluation of concrete pavements

- 12 papers presented
- Main topics covered:
  - Concrete pavement temperature, thermal stresses
  - Stresses induced by (dynamic) traffic loads
  - Local calibration of pavement performance models
  - Joints
  - Field behaviour vs. modelling

#### **Continuously reinforced concrete pavements**

- 6 papers presented
- Main topics:
  - Sustainability related considerations for design, performance and construction
  - Effects of load speed on traffic induced stresses
  - Effects of asphalt interlayer on thermal stresses
  - Surface notches (crack inducers) to obtain more regular crack pattern

#### **Innovations**

- 4 papers presented
- Main topics:
  - Porous concrete pavement
  - (Ultra Thin) concrete overlay on asphalt pavement
  - Innovative and durable maintenance and repair on airports
- Paper by Bredenhann, Burger and van Zyl presented during this session
  - Focussed on performance of UTCRCP on truck crawler lane between Huguenot tunnel and toll plaza (N1/1)





### 8<sup>th</sup> DUT Workshop: Keynote speech

- Delivered by Prof A.A.A. Molenaar
- "Is there a future for concrete pavements?"
- Yes, but concrete road industry will have to work smarter in order to leverage advantages
  - E.g. Precast pavements
  - Improve models used in LCCA to show advantages of concrete (perpetual pavements)
  - Further development of use of recycled concrete in pavements

- Gave a perspective on concrete road industry in USA and how lessons learnt over 5 decades can direct the future of concrete pavements

- Main topics:
  - Surface characteristics
  - Environmental assessment
  - Energy efficiency
  - Recycling
  - Social aspects
  - PPP projects



- Solutions for Urban Areas 15 papers, 3 posters
- Main topics:
  - Concrete roundabouts
  - Dedicated Public Transport Lanes
  - Bus Stops
  - High Quality Surface
  - Roller Compacted Concrete
  - Electrified Pavements
  - Heated Transportation Infrastructures



- Design and Construction 35 papers, 12 posters
