Resolutions

Resolution 1



- Road Funding: The need for a more realistic future sustainable road funding model & associated funding policy:
 - to be researched and incorporated into road policy formulation and associated documents - more R&D needed
 - e.g. Impact: reduced income - issue of fuel levy vs electric cars, etc;
 - NB: Roads Industry (via RPF) to be part of this discussion and associated R&D

Resolution 2



- SAFCEC to assist Road Authorities (via RPF) with the challenge of *more accurate* information sharing w.r.t current and future cash flow forecast & cost planning information:
 - Larger firms & Smaller firms;
 - Including Training/Capacity components;

Resolution 3

- Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA):
 - Need to work closer with the *roads industry* (via *RPF*) in order to agree on definitions/classification/licensing of “waste”, “secondary”, “hazardous” materials..., recycled asphalt (RA)..,etc;
 - Example of Ash (Eskom);
 - Job opportunities, utilization essential;
 - Not excluding other National Departments such as Water Affairs (DWA);
 - Stakeholder Awareness;
 - Regulations/Policy issues;
