Resolutions

Resolution 1



- That the issue of climate-adaptive pavement construction processes focussing on reduced potable water and non-potable water usage be presented and discussed at the next RPF

Resolution 2



- That an RPF Digital Working Group be established, initially to focus on the legal use of drones and drone-based technology in road projects, and to be expanded in future to identify, classify and prioritise other useful digital tools that can benefit the roads industry (e.g. laser scanning, IOT devices, mobile data capture, etc.)

Resolution 3



- For RPF organisers to liaise with the CAPSA Technical Committee to discuss the resolutions presented and to determine response to the resolutions and an RPF 4-year programme prior to CAPSA 2023

Resolution 4



- That an RPF working group on self-healing materials be established led by the CSIR
