Minerals Council interventions



Key elements of interventions

Prevention

Risk assessment of workplaces and vulnerable employees

Management of cases, including screening, testing, isolation, quarantine and reporting

Collaboration on regional basis among companies and with the public health system

Additional funding for disease mapping, training and research



DMRE Guideline on COVID-19

- Published on 18th May 2020 and effective 25th May.
- Regulates the mining industry on COVID-19.
- Available on Minerals Council website.
- DMRE inspectors monitor implementation.
- Collaboration between DMRE and DOH essential, with DOH acting as advisor.

South African Context

- The epidemic is maturing.
- Most provinces with mining operations have low testing rates:

Province	Tests done per 100 000 population
Western Cape	1 211
Gauteng	837
Free State	667
KZN	601
Eastern Cape	568
Northern Cape	291
Mpumalanga	249
North West	144
Limpopo	138

Need to consider more testing and collaboration.




Key insights

- "The epidemic will be with us for some time- We have to live with it". *Minister Mantashe, 26th May*
- "Save lives and livelihoods" Mr Mxolisi Mgojo, President Minerals Council, 26th May
- Should we be testing?
 - Public health approach says test more.
 - Testing constraints in country.
 - Follow National Institute for Communicable Diseases Protocols.
 - Mass screening following incidents has revealed high levels of COVID-19, mostly undetected.
 - Value of testing when epidemic is ramping up?
- Asymptomatic cases
 - High rates
 - Not clear what their outcomes will be or if it's a special population currently at work.
- Closure of mines due to COVID-19
 - Meeting with CloM.
 - Will we be able to continue to stop and start for cases?
- The future is clear,as MUD
