Instead of combining all six parts into one document, we recommend that there be two SANS specifications:

1. SANS 1083: Aggregates for concrete, mortar and plaster

2. SANS???: Aggregates for Asphalt Mixes, Seals and Micro-Surfacing

PART 1 Aggregates for concrete To replace current SANS 1083

PART 2 Aggregates for Mortar and Plaster To replace current SANS 1090

To be set up by industry – and to cover Part 5 and 6

PART 5 Aggregates for Asphalt Mixes Based on new COTO document

PART 6 Aggregates for Seals and Micro-Surfacing Based on new COTO document

Part 4 and 5

• COTO document – no SANS Spec required

PART 4 Granular Materials for Road Construction Based on new COTO document

• Transnet Spec – no SANS Spec required

PART 3 Aggregates for Ballast and Gabions Based on Current Transnet spec and SANS 1200 DK

SANS 1083: Aggregates for concrete, mortar and plaster

Currently all comments are being collated. ASPASA members will then comment on the document – and early 2025, meeting to be held to finalise the document.

It can then be submitted to SABS – who will follow their normal process, formatting, send to working group, etc.
